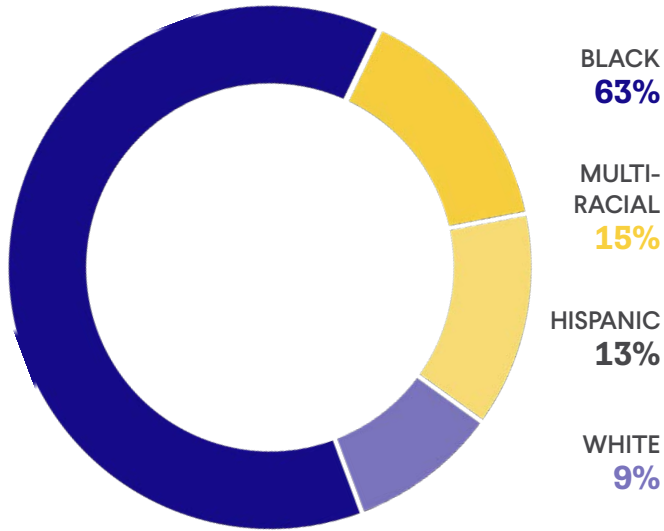

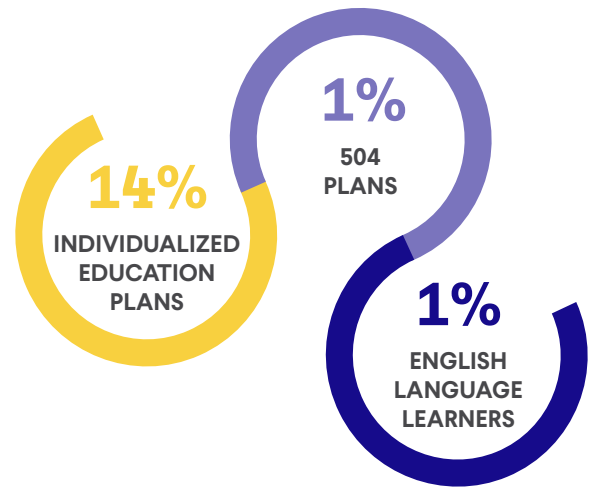

## STUDENT DEMOGRAPHICS



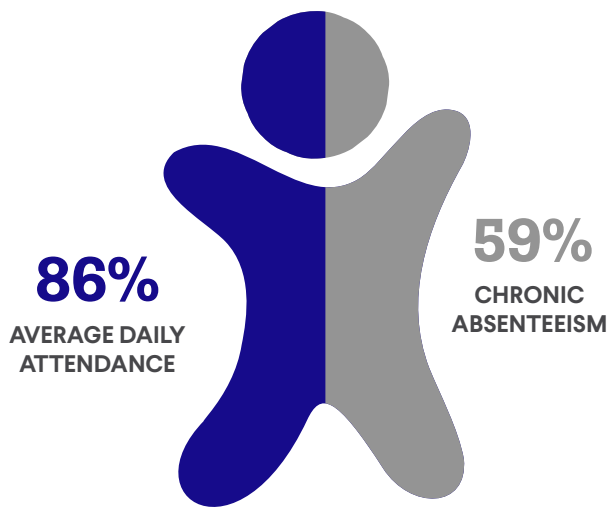

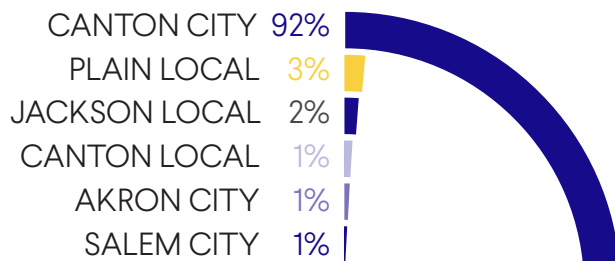

## ACADEMIC PROGRESS

Through a well-rounded curriculum that engages students and the support of tutoring and summer programs, Canton College Preparatory School is undergoing steady academic recovery since the pandemic. All eligible students completed the i-Ready diagnostic and Ohio State Test assessments within the windows provided. The school met state expectations for student academic growth (3 Stars, Progress) and increased its Performance Index (PI) Score by over 7%.

### YOY GROWTH IN PERFORMANCE INDEX SCORE



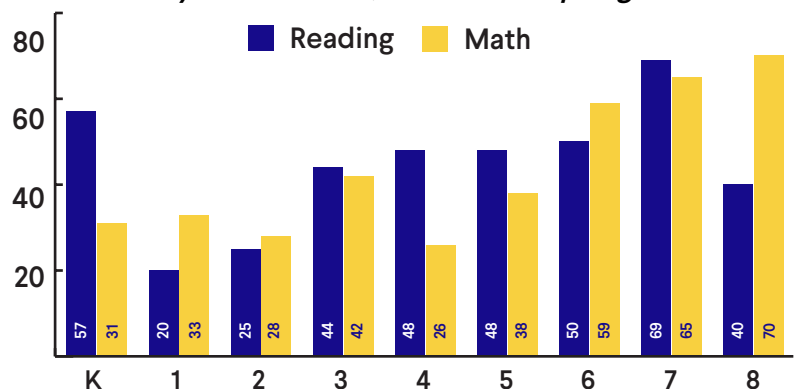

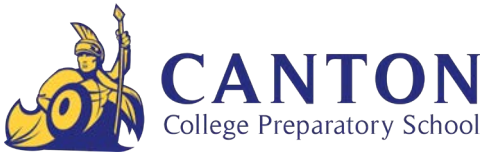
